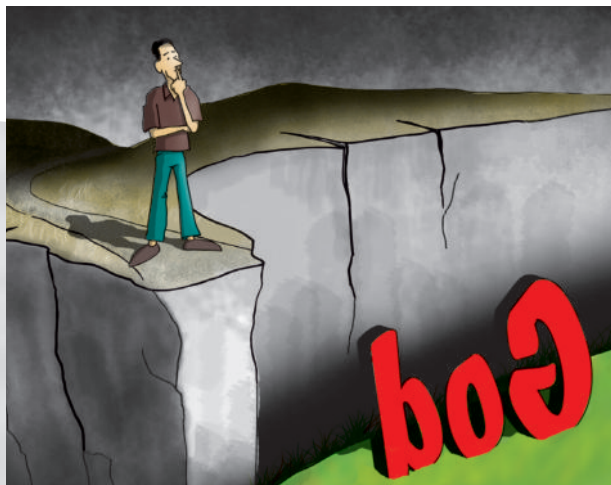

He loves us so much that he wants us to know him. His plan is to give our life a real purpose and to have fellowship with us eternally.

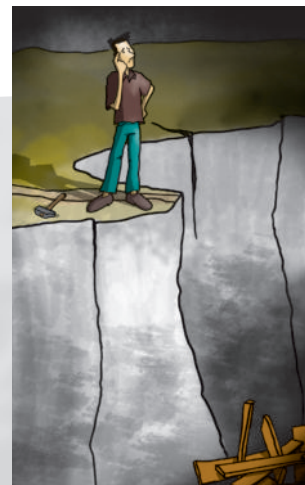
